Sunroom Window Options

- **Double Hung Windows:** Full screens allow window to open from the bottom or the top; you can also open both panels for ventilation.
- **Casement Windows:** Swing to open as window is hinged on one side.
- **Awning Windows:** Swing bottom half outward for ventilation as window is hinged at the top.
- **Bay or Bow Windows:** A series of windows that expand your view.
- **Picture Windows:** Large windows that do not open.
- **Transom Windows:** Windows over doors or larger windows that do not open.
- **Sidelite Windows:** Windows on side of entry door that does not open.
- **Custom Shaped Windows:** Custom windows we can make like hopper, hexagon, round, arched, oval, eyebrow and quarter arch.

Sunroom Window Treatments Options

- **Shades:** Stylish and functional, window shades are an affordable window covering choice. Our shades are available in an array of styles and colors.
- **Blinds:** Blinds are available with horizontal or vertical slats. This affordable window covering is available in wood or vinyl options.

- **Gable Roof:** A roof that slopes downward from a central ridge to form a gable at one end. From the outside, the ridge and downward slope of the roof looks like a capital A.
- **Solarium:** A glass roof with either a straight eave or a combination option, this makes your sunroom brighter and warmer from the incoming sunlight.
